WHEREAS, this matter coming on for hearing pursuant to public notice as provided by law, all members being present and there being no objection, and the same having been published in the Chronicle on November 6, 2025; and

WHEREAS, RCW 86.15.140 includes provisions for the adoption of annual budget reflecting estimated revenues and expenditures for the coming year, to be adopted through a duly publicized hearing and a majority vote of the supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Chehalis River Basin Flood Control District (District) has estimated its annual revenues and expenditures in accordance with the statute and is prepared to take public comment and adopt a budget; and


WHEREAS, all members of the board of supervisors of the Chehalis River Basin Flood Control Zone District have had reasonable notice of time, place and purpose of this meeting and of the proposed budget;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that expenditures in the amount of \$3,431,000 and revenue in the amount of \$3,431,000 be estimated. Funds will be placed in the budget within Munis fund no. 65N1 as indicated and distributed in the revenue and expenditure account as outlined in the attached Schedule A. Funds may legally be transferred from one item to another within said budget.

The foregoing resolution was ADOPTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Chehalis River Basin Flood Control Zone District at a special open public meeting this 25 day of November 2025.





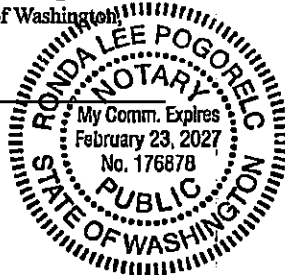
